January's blizzard brought more than just a large amount of snow. It also brought out the things that make this community a great place to live in and raise a family.

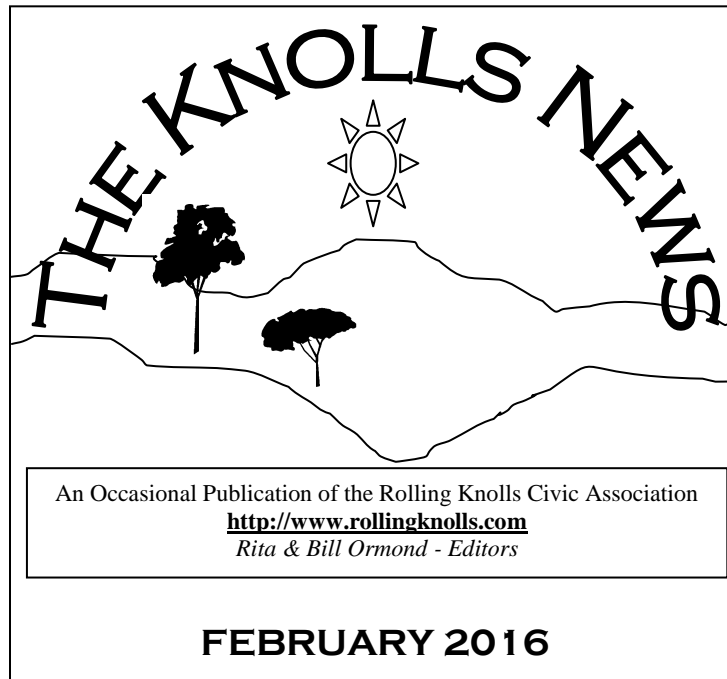
